Female V/O: You can also volunteer at your local animal shelter.

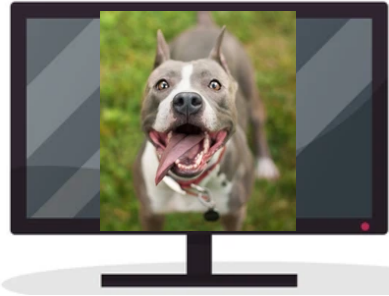
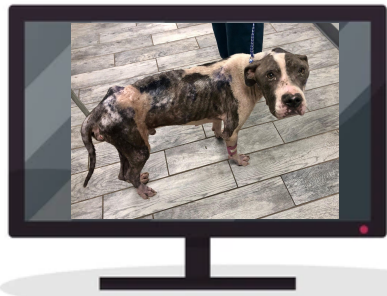
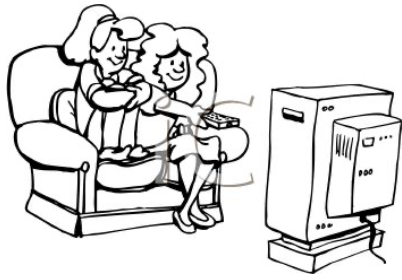
